19th Century S. Caucasian Moghan Carpet

Description

Untold thousands of tiny botehs swim on the mustard yellow field of this unusual southeast Caucasian carpet. There are no other elements to interrupt their movement in this c. 1880 rug. The ivory main border employs squared-off medallions inside the red rosette inner minor. As with Moghans generally, the pile is lowish and the weave is fine to facilitate crisp drawing.
